Risk Factors

- **Immunizations:** Low percentage of males 65+ have received pneumococcal vaccination [SAG=62%, ME=71%]
- **Prevention:** Lowest percentage hypertensives of any county reporting medical provider advised to cut down on salt in past year [SAG=52%, ME=62%]
- **Smoking:** Low percentage of current smokers have used Maine Tobacco Quitline [SAG=13%, ME=19%]
- **Alcohol and Substance Use:**
 - Highest percentage of 45-64 year olds in any county reporting binge drinking in past month [SAG=20%, ME=14%]
 - Highest percentage of any county reporting current substance abuse problem [SAG=3.0%, ME=1.5%]
- **Youth (Grades 9-12):** High percentage report suicidal ideation [SAG=16%, ME=14%]

- **Access to Care:**
 - Low percentage uninsured [SAG=10%, ME=13%], without usual source of medical care [SAG=10%, ME=13%], and with unmet medical care needs due to cost [SAG=5.4%, ME=6.5%]
 - Low percentage with no dental visit in past 2 years [SAG=21%, ME=24%]
- **Immunizations:** 2nd Highest percentage of males in any county received flu shot or mist in past year [SAG=46%, ME=40%]
- **Overweight/Obesity:** Low percentage of obese residents [SAG=23%, ME=28%]
- **Smoking:** Highest percentage of current smokers in any county tried to quit in past year [SAG=67%, ME=54%]
- **Reproductive Health:** Low teen birth rate and lowest percentage infants born with inadequate prenatal care of any county [SAG=1.5%, ME=2.5%]
- **Alcohol and Substance Use:** Lowest percentage of any county reporting misuse of prescription drugs in past month [SAG=0.2%, ME=1.8%]
- **Youth (Grades 9-12):**
 - High percentage consuming fruits and vegetables 5 times per day [SAG=17%, ME=15%]
 - Low percentage reporting smokeless tobacco use [SAG=7.3%, ME=9.5%], inhalant use [SAG=7.4%, ME=9.3%] and misuse of prescription drugs [SAG=9.2%, ME=11%]

Disease Incidence & Prevalence

- **COPD:** High prevalence of COPD [SAG=5.6%, ME=4.2%]
- **Cancer:** High incidence of melanoma and prostate cancers
- **Diabetes:** Highest prevalence of diabetes among elderly (65+) in any county [SAG=28%, ME=21%]
- **Mental Health:** Highest percentage of any county receiving outpatient mental health treatment in past year [SAG=17%, ME=11%]
- **Infectious Disease:** High incidence rate for gonorrhea

- **Heart Disease:** Low prevalence of heart disease [SAG=3.5%, ME=6.3%]
- **Cancer:** Low incidence of bladder, breast, cervical, colorectal and lung cancers
- **Mental Health:** Low percentage report unmet mental health treatment needs in past year [SAG=3.8%, ME=4.8%]
