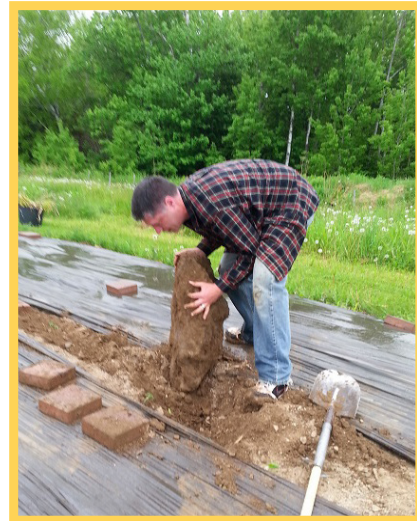


Helping Hands in the Community Garden
