In its sixth year, the Antique Appraisal Show has again successfully benefited the EMHS LiveSAFE program, which provides emergency response services to elderly and disabled residents throughout Maine. In four hours, Bruce appraised more than 100 antiques, raising \$1,740. All proceeds benefit low income subscribers to EMHS LiveSAFE.
